3. Viability of the idea

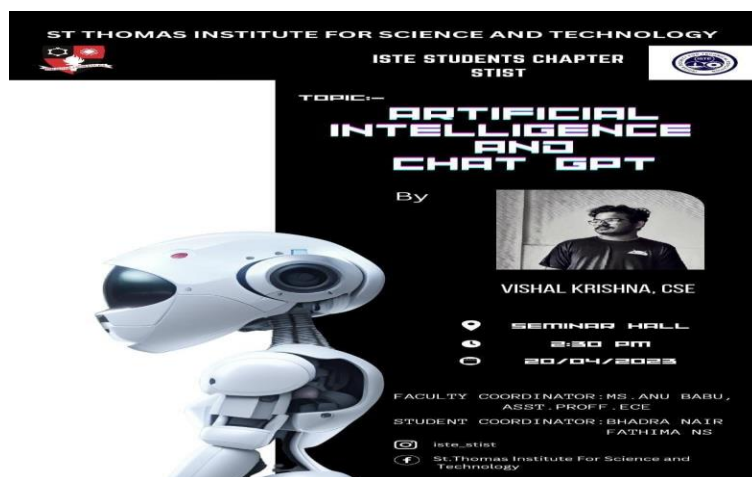
After careful evaluation, the winners of the event are Muhammed R, Anshu Kumar, Johana Mariyam Varghese, Darshan of S6 CSE.

The ISTE Student Chapter STIST organized a seminar on “Artificial Intelligence and ChatGPT” on 20/04/2023.

Artificial intelligence is the simulation of human intelligence processes by machines, especially computer systems. Specific applications of AI include expert systems, natural language processing, speech recognition, and machine vision. ChatGPT is a sibling model to instruct GPT, which is trained to follow instructions in a prompt and provide a detailed response.

The expert in the program was **Mr. Vishal Krishna** of CSE, STIST. The event was attended by 39 students and 3 faculty members. The event was organized by Mrs. Anu Babu, ISTE Faculty Advisor, Assistant professor in ECE.
